SPIRITUAL GIFTS

• **1 Corinthians 12:4-11**

There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.

Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. Dream Team Honor Code



As an essential part of the C4 Church Dream Team family, you have a responsibility to develop and exhibit mature Christian behavior. This should be the basic premise of your desire to participate in a servant-position here at C4 Church.

While serving the Body of Christ as a servant-leader at C4, you pledge to present a good appearance at all times. In both attire and behavior, you should strive to demonstrate Biblical standards in all situations.

As Christians, the way we present ourselves to others is of vital importance to the way others perceive Christ. Our conduct should never be an embarrassment to Christ, but should exemplify the best qualities of a mature believer and servant-leader.

Making sure the priorities in life are aligned with the life of Christ, C4 leaders are to be faithful in areas such as giving, attendance, and communication within the Church. Being faithful in attendance does not mean mandatory attendance at all times, but it does mean supporting the Church body by attending as you are able and communicating with other leaders when you are not.

Exemplifying the highest moral commitment, C4 leaders are to maintain a disciplined life of Bible reading, prayer, and fasting. Growth in these areas is representative of our walk with Christ and servant-leaders should aspire to attain refraining from such things as:

- Indulging in addictive behaviors
- Sexual immorality (sexual activity outside of marriage and/or pornography)
- Unbiblical sexual lifestyles of any type, unbiblical gender identities, or affirmation of unbiblical ideologies
- All behaviors which might cause Christ to grieve and others to stumble

By providing an example in speech and action, we encourage others to grow in Christ and become servant-leaders themselves. This is a way of life measured by the heart and commitment of each leader in the C4 family. We should regard it as an essential part of our development, not as an imposition or restriction.

Abuse Policy



I understand that C4 Church is a safe place for children and vulnerable adults and that C4 complies with all Federal and State laws regarding reporting suspected child abuse. As a member of the Dream Team, I understand that suspected abuse is to be reported to the staff member who oversees the area in which I serve. I also understand the four types of abuse defined below:

- Physical: a physical act directed at a child or vulnerable adult that causes injury.
- Sexual: contact or interactions between a child and an adult, or another child, when the child is being used for sexual stimulation of the perpetrator or another person. This includes exploitation through photographs, videos, or other communication methods.
- Emotional: acts or omissions by the parent or other caregivers that have caused, or could cause, serious behavioral, cognitive, emotional, or mental disorders.
- Neglect: failure to provide for the child or vulnerable adult's basic needs. This includes adequate adult supervision, medical attention, housing, food, and clothing. Most cases of physical neglect involve inadequate adult supervision that has caused harm to the child or vulnerable adult or places them in danger of such harm.

I understand it is not my responsibility to investigate and in no instance will I confront a parent or caregiver if abuse is suspected. As a member of the Dream Team, I agree to comply with this policy and report any suspected abuse to the staff person who oversees the area in which I serve.
